Overview of Proposed Grant Program:

Warren County seeks a planning grant through the OAA that allows the county to bring together community stakeholders to develop a strategic plan for abatement intervention, select Opioid mitigation strategies that make sense in the community, and plan for strategy implementation. The county is seeking to facilitate a strategic planning process for the Opioid Abatement Funding available to the county. This will be accomplished by developing an actionable plan to develop and implement a scope of services to prevent, treat, and maintain long-term recovery of individuals with OUD/SUD.

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Summary of Staff Review and Recommendations

Warren County has developed a request for proposal (RFP) to hire a professional to facilitate a strategic planning process for the county that will result in an actionable plan to develop and implement a scope of services to prevent, treat, and maintain long-term recovery of substance use and addiction. This process will result in a strategic plan that presents a clear approach and planning process supported by relevant data and analysis of trends, identification of opportunities and strategies, a process to prioritize and focus County program and services, and an implementation plan with performance measures that track progress on achieving the goals of the plan. The proposed cost total is \$50,000 with Warren County providing a match of \$5,000 from their Direct Distribution fund, resulting in an OAA request of \$45,000.

OAA staff recommends full approval of this request with a contingency that any RFPs issued will include cooperative procurement language.
